

Cattle Grazing and Eucalypt Regrowth are Compatible



This photo was taken looking along the stock barrier. Protected area is to the right of picture. Unprotected area shows no change. All trees are straight. The tops of them have not been eaten by anything. **CATTLE do not eat Eucalypt regrowth.**

Taken on Dargo Road, near Twelve Mile Creek. Travelling stock route to the Dargo High Plains. Edge of Alpine Ash regrowth. Shows undamaged trees outside stock barrier. Approx. 1,000 head of cattle are driven up and down here each year. Hurley's cattle graze here all season
